ACCOMODATION SUGGESTIONS

Regarding the accomodation for participants, Palladian recomends the following hotels which are all located on or near Syntagma Square, within five minutes walking distance from the meeting venue.

Syntagma Square (Greek: Πλατεία Συντάγματος, pronounced [platia syntagmatos], "Constitution Square"), is the central square of Athens. The Square is named after the Constitution that the first King of Greece Otto was obliged to grant, after a popular and military uprising on September 3, 1843. It is located in front of the 19th century Old Royal Palace, housing the Greek Parliament since 1934. Syntagma Square is the most important square of modern Athens from both a historical and social point of view, at the epicentre of commercial activity, Greek political life and countless demonstrations over the last few years.
